\*The UO Study Abroad Fee is \$300 per UO term. This comes out to: \$300 for fall semester (1 UO term), \$600 for spring semester (2 UO terms). Students will also be charged their UO major resource fees.

\*\*Students placed in Homestays will have breakfast and dinner provided during the week and three meals a day on weekends. Estimated cost for lunches during the week is \$500 per semester.

†The estimate for personal expenses does not include personal travel or entertainment.

**NOTE: The costs listed above are estimates only, based on information available in June 2007. Expenses may increase due to a falling exchange rate, increased program costs, increased tuition, inflation or other factors. CIEE reserves the right to adjust fees at any time.**

### Payment Schedule

All payments are made to the University of Oregon and must be paid before leaving the U.S. A billing statement will be sent upon acceptance. The \$300 deposit must be paid upon acceptance.

### Refund Policy

The \$50 application fee and \$300 CIEE deposit are non-refundable under any circumstances.

After the beginning date of the program there will be no refund of the UO Study Abroad fee.
