Payment Schedule

The UO study abroad fee of \$300 per UO term will be charged to the student's UO billing account. Students must pay the fee by the billing date.

SIT will bill participants directly for all other costs. Students paying with financial aid should consult with Marj Biehler in the Office of International Programs for assistance completing the SIT Financial Aid Information Sheet.

Refund Policy of the UO Study Abroad Fee

Students who withdraw before the beginning date of the program will receive a full refund less \$50.

After the beginning date of the program there will be no refunds.

All refund requests must be made in writing and must include the reasons for withdrawing.

SIT has a separate refund policy for its program fees. Withdrawal dates and fees are explained in the SIT "Conditions of Participation" form.
