SPRING SEMESTER Course Information for UO Students

Placement Test: Each student will take a placement test at the beginning of each term in Angers. Students' course work and credits will vary according to the CIDEF level into which they place. (CIDEF is the language institute in Angers.)

CIDEF Levels: The CIDEF system has six levels: Initiation, Elementaire, Moyen 1er Degré, Moyen 2e Degré, Moyen 3e Degré, and Supérieur.

General Limitations: Students should note that the UO requires placement into at least certain minimal Angers levels in order to receive credit for correspondingly high UO course numbers. These limitations are as follows:

- 400-level FR credit for the “langue” course is granted only to students who place into either the *Moyen 3e Degré* or *Supérieur* levels.

What Students Take in Angers: (1) Students placed into **all** levels take a **required** language course (“*Langue*”). (2) Students have the *option* of taking the Northwest professor's course (shown in a different chart—see <http://studyabroad.uoregon.edu>). (3) Students then fill up the remainder of their schedule with elective courses chosen from the lists in this handout. Some electives are special language courses, and others address various aspects of French culture.

The OANG Course Code: All courses taken in Angers will show up under the OANG course code on your UO transcript (this indicates “**O**verseas Program **A**ngers”). The code for the UO subject in which you received credit is embedded in the title; for example: “FR: 1st Year French” means that the course is credited as French (FR is the UO's subject code for French).

Initiation, Elementaire, and Moyen 1er Degré
