Payment Schedule

Students will be charged a \$300 per UO term Study Abroad Fee. This fee will be charged to the student's UO account at the beginning of each UO term. Students will also be charged their UO major resource fees.

AHA International will bill participants directly for the program costs. Students paying with financial aid must consult with Marj Biehler in Study Abroad Programs prior to the final payment date.

Refund Policy of the UO Study Abroad Fee

Students who withdraw before the beginning date of the program will receive a full refund less \$50.

After the beginning date of the program there will be no refunds.

All refund requests must be made in writing and must include the reasons for withdrawing.
